



Dear Glade Run Lake Conservancy member,

Your donated time will help save Glade Run Lake!

Glade Run Lake Conservancy is working to secure grant money as part of a multi-year strategy to fix the dam, remove lake sediment and improve the surrounding property. One of the requirements of these grants is for GRLC to commit a level of its own funds that the grant provider would then match dollar for dollar. Volunteer hours ("In Kind Service") can be substituted as part of GRLC's funding commitment. The more "In Kind" hours we donate, the less out-of-pocket money would be needed from the GRLC treasury, thus ensuring that the Conservancy has funds available for future lake maintenance needs. But we need your help. Please join the members of the GRLC Board by committing to donate a small amount of your time over the next couple of years to help with the lake.

Here's how to help

We need pledges for as many "In Kind Service" hours that we can generate for 2014 and 2015. We ask that you pledge time at the following level: 12 hours a year for adults, 24 hours a year for families and 40 hours a year for businesses. However, any amount you can donate is appreciated and you can always donate more than what we are suggesting. We will have a variety of tasks that you can consider helping with from clerical to hands-on maintenance at the site. We understand that your availability may change over time, but we appreciate your pledge now so that we can complete the grant applications by their deadlines.
