Membership Policy and Code of Ethics for Members

Purpose of Membership

1. To inform the public about efforts to restore Glade Run Lake.
2. To demonstrate to government officials and other potential funding sources strong local support by number of membership.
3. Provide small seed fund to support initial administrative costs.
4. To encourage individual members to contribute suggestions, talent, professional skills and other resources to the effort to restore Glade Run Lake.

Eligibility

Any individual who shares the goal of raising funds to restore and improve Glade Run Lake is eligible to become a member.

Establishment of Membership

- A. Paid memberships are for a period of 3 years and include the following:
 1. Individual, 2. Family, 3. Student
- B. Complimentary or honorary membership - may be bestowed at the discretion of the Board of Directors (e.g. At a specific donation level)
 1. Serving on the Board or as part of a committee or other work group will not entitle an individual to complimentary membership.
- C. Membership categories and dues structure may be expanded or changed pending approval by a majority vote of the Board of Directors.

Ethics

All members are expected to abide by the GRLC code of conduct in performance of any membership duties.
